



## About The 100 Women Campaign

The 100 Women Campaign is a fundraising initiative of the Pembroke Petawawa District Community Foundation. 100 women contribute \$100 to raise \$10,000. Some women contributed themselves, while others contributed on behalf of women who are important in their lives. 2014 was the first year of this initiative.

Each year, \$10,000 is raised and divided two ways. \$5,000 is put into an endowment fund within the Foundation where interest is accrued and reinvested in women's initiatives. The second \$5,000 is immediately returned to the community to help women. In 2014, there are three organizations who are recipients of the 100 Women Campaign.

In addition to participating in the 100 Women Campaign, individuals are welcome to contribute to the growing endowment fund for women at anytime. These donations will contribute to the growing of dollars through investment - the "giving that grows" aspect of the Foundation.

## The 100 Women Fund Recipients

Three local organizations were recipients of fundraising from the 100 Women Campaign. These organizations include:

### **The Bernadette McCann House**

Donation: \$1,750

The donation is going to purchase cleaning kits and first aid kits for young mothers that help maintain clean surroundings and access to emergency first aid if necessary.

### **Community Living Upper Ottawa Valley**

Donation: \$1500

The donation is going to support three women who are clients of Community Living. Two will be support with a business clothing allowance in order to participate as part of a Speakers' Bureau. The other recipient will use some of the money to upgrade her wheelchair.

### **The Petawawa Military Family Resource Centre**

Donation: \$1,750

The donation is going towards an event to honour the women (spouses, mothers and daughters) who support the troops. These women are often the unsung heroes who make sacrifices at home while soldiers make sacrifices for the country.

Each year, three organizations will benefit immediately from \$5,000 of the \$10,000 raised. The remaining \$5,000 will be dedicated to an endowment fund for women's issues within the Foundation where earnings growth will be redirected to the same cause. This fund will continue to grow each year.

In addition to the 100 Women Campaign, anyone can make a donation to the women's fund and help the Foundation grow this incredible opportunity to benefit women in the region.
